- Open the Honorlock tool from your course content (Figure 1). Note: If you do not have the Honorlock tool in your course yet, please refer to the Honorlock Faculty Guide.
- 2. Click on the **menu icon** at the top right of the page, then click **Add Practice Assessment** (Figure 2).

3. Click **Confirm**. The practice assessment will be added to your course (Figure 3).



4. In the Honorlock assessment list, click the Enable button (Figure 4).





- 5. Configure the proctoring options as needed. Once you're done, click **Enable** at the bottom of the page.
- 6. Click the **Go there now** link to open the practice assessment's settings (Figure 5).
