This guide will teach you how to set up exam profiles in Honorlock. Exam profiles allow you to apply Honorlock settings to multiple different exams. For more information, please refer to the <u>Honorlock support page</u>.

Create a New Profile

- 1. Open the **Honorlock tool** from your course menu (Figure 1).
- 2. Click on the **menu** button at the top right corner, then click **Manage Profiles** (Figure 2).

3. Click the **New Profile** button to create a new profile (Figure 3).

1. From the main Honorlock page, click the **Settings** button next to the exam (Figure 6).

2. At the top of the page, click the Assessment Profiles button (Figure 7).



3. Select a **profile** from the dropdown, then click **Apply** (Figure 8).
