


This document will teach you how to create a video quiz using Kaltura. Quiz questions can be inserted into a video to be answered by students. You can then embed the quiz into your Blackboard course. Grades are automatically entered into the Blackboard Grade Center.

1. Navigate to the Blackboard content area where you are embedding the video quiz.
 - Alternatively, if you are not sure where you are placing the video quiz, you can access My Media through the Tools area of the Blackboard main course menu then start at step 4 of this document.

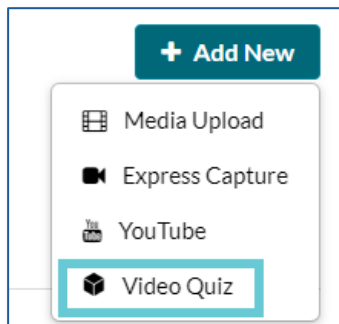
2. Click on **Build Content**:



3. Scroll and click on **Kaltura Video Quiz (LTI)**:

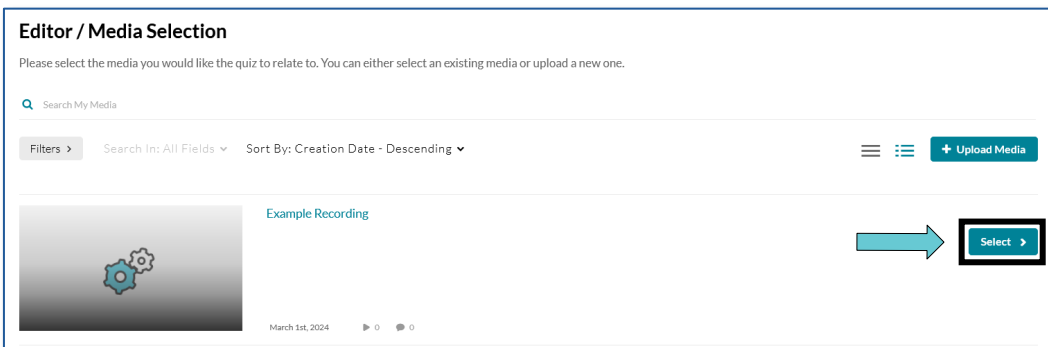


4. Click on **Add New** & choose **Video Quiz**:

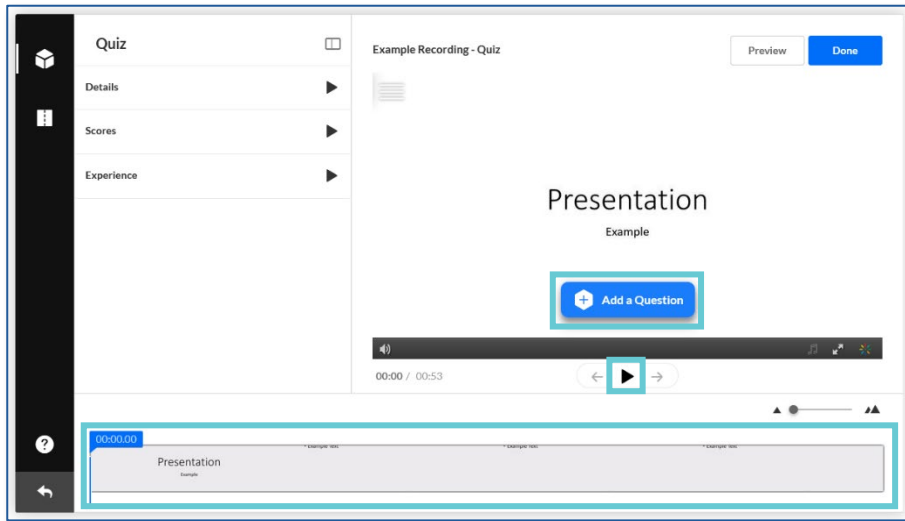


Note: You can only turn videos you've already uploaded to Kaltura into video quizzes. You can upload a video by clicking [Media Upload](#) or record a new video by clicking [Kaltura Capture](#) under Add New.

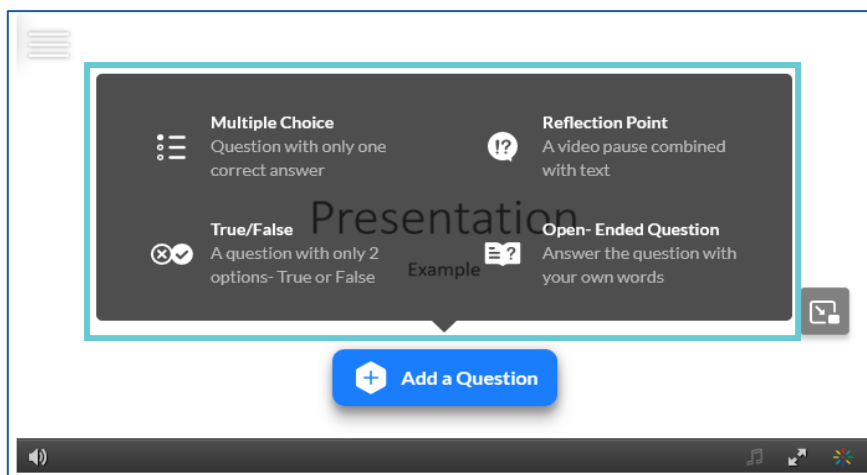
5. Select the recording you'd like to use as your video quiz by clicking the **Select** button.



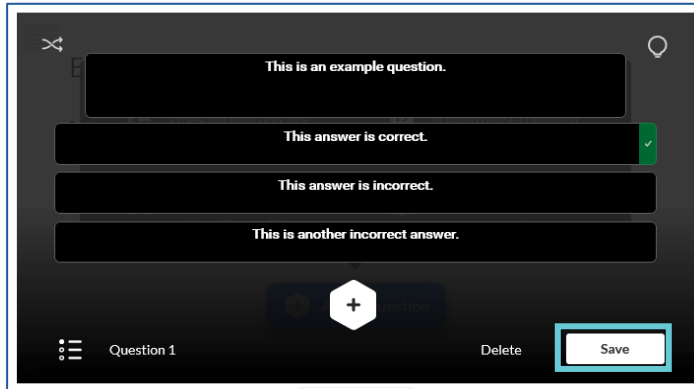
You will be presented with the following interface.




6. You can play your video by clicking the **Play** button and seek through your video using the bar on the bottom. To add a question to the quiz at a certain time marker, click **Add a Question**. You can add questions throughout the video by scrolling through the video and stopping at the time marker where you want your question inserted.
7. Upon creating a new question, you will be presented with the following options (Figure 5).
 - **Multiple Choice**: Students must pick the correct answer to a question.
 - **True/False**: Students must pick whether a statement is true or false.
 - **Reflection Point**: Pauses the video with text. Students do not have to answer a question.
 - **Open-Ended Question**: Students provide a text response to a question.

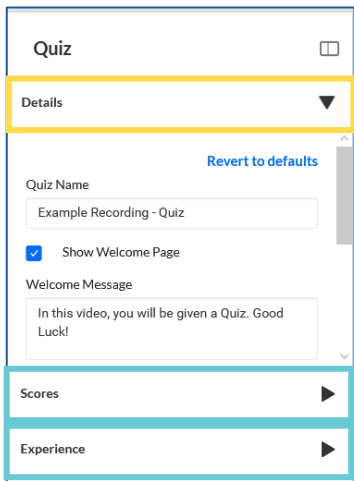


8. Enter the options for the answers, the **correct answer** should be placed in the box that has the green box with a checkmark.

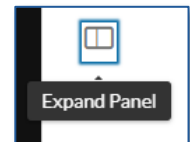


9. If your question requires more than 2 answer options, click on the  to add another answer.
10. Once you've finished entering your question, click **Save**.
- When a student gets to the point in the video quiz where you created the question, the video will pause and prompt them to answer it.

The panel on the **left** allows you to configure quiz settings. If you do not see this option, click on the **Expand Panel** option:



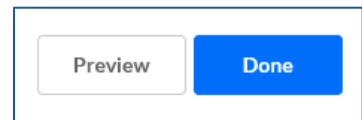
Click on **Details**, **Scores**, or **Experience** to show the settings for each category (Figure 7).



- Details category:**
 - Quiz Name:** The name which will be displayed for the quiz.
 - Show Welcome Page:** Controls whether a starting page with the name and message will be shown when a student begins the quiz.
 - Welcome Message:** A message which will be shown to students when starting the quiz.
 - Allow Download of Questions List:** Controls whether students can download the questions before starting the quiz.
 - Instructions:** Displays the text "All questions must be answered. The quiz will be submitted at the end."
- Scores category:**
 - Allow Multiple Attempts:** Controls whether students can take the quiz multiple times.
 - Number of Attempts:** The number of attempts available for the quiz.
 - Quiz Score to Keep:** The score which should be saved out of all attempts.
 - Do Not Show Scores/Show Scores:** Controls whether students can see their scores on the quiz after it is finished.

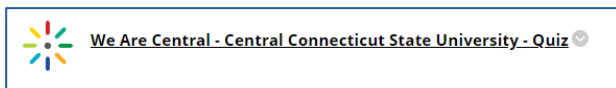
- **Include Answers:** Sets whether students can see the questions they got correct or incorrect with their scores.
- **Experience category:**
 - **Allow Answers Change:** Allows students to go back to previous questions to change their answers before they submit the quiz.
 - **Allow Skip/Do not Allow Skip:** Allows students to skip the question and return to it later. If skipping isn't allowed, students must give an answer to continue.
 - **No Seeking Forward:** Disables using the seek bar to skip ahead in the video.

11. Once you have finished setting up your quiz, click **Done** on the top right corner to save it, or **Preview** to view a preview of the quiz.

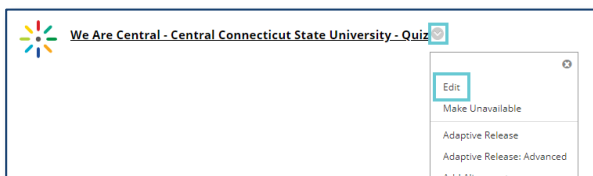


12. You can then embed your video quiz into Blackboard with Grade Center integration. To do so, click on the “</> **Save and Embed**” Option.

13. Once the Quiz is embedded, you will be redirected back to your Blackboard course and the link will look like this:



14. To edit settings and add points, etc. to the quiz, click on the **drop-down arrow** next to the link and select **Edit**.



- Here you can add Points Possible, Due Date, Description, and other options such as Date Restrictions and Attachments.
