

Randomize Test Answer Order

If you choose to randomize the order of answers for a test question, the answers will be shown in a different order every time the test is taken. This may be helpful to deter cheating.

1. Click the **grey arrow** next to the multiple-choice test you would like to randomize the test answers for and click **Edit the Test** (Figure 1).

2. Click the grey arrow next to a multiple-choice question and click Edit (Figure 2).
